## Vocabulary, reading

### 21-20. GO mental Fundamental & GO mental

The most fun your brain can have. Each question contains 4 things: one is the odd one out, the others are somehow connected. Simply name the odd one out and make the connection between the other 3. Includes board, 6 brain pawns, timer, 84 steal/challenge cards, and 560 or 1000 questions.

## Vocabulary

### 52. The Chain Game
